



Stanwood-Camano Island Pride Booth Checklist

Thank you for participating in the Pride event at Freedom Park on the first Saturday in June from 12PM-4PM. We have put together this checklist to help you have a smooth set-up and tear-down.

- **Please note there is no power or water available for your booth at the park.**
- **Driving on the grass is not permitted as it is the septic drain field for all of Camano Commons and can be easily damaged. Your tent, tables, and supplies will need to be carried to your booth location (less than 100'). We suggest bringing a wagon or hand truck and parking by the Park and Ride on the west side of the park.**

BRING THE FOLLOWING:

- 10' x 10' tent plus weights – It can get very windy at the park, and we have had tents blow around in the past. Please bring weights to anchor the tent. Stakes are not allowed due to septic pipes under the grass. Some easy ideas are: 1 gallon jug filled with water, cement blocks, bricks. You can also tether tents together to make it more difficult for them to move.
- Chairs and tables
- Camera – this is a great opportunity to take pics of your booth to promote on social media. **#stanwoodcamanopride**, FB and Instagram **@stanwoodcamanopride**

- Snacks and water – Camano Commons offers food, baked goods, and ice cream as well
- Rain, snow, and/or sun gear – because you just never know what the weather will be in June.
- Cash box or way to take payments

We will have volunteers starting Saturday at 10:00 am to help guide you to your booth location, as well as show you where to park to unload and load. That should provide enough time for you to be set-up and be ready to roll by Noon. If you need additional time, please email and we will try to accommodate. Please do not break down your booth until 4PM.

FINALLY, be ready to paint the town Rainbow! Your support shows that we have a loving, caring, and supporting community. Having this event at Freedom Park is so fitting. In the words of Marlo Thomas, here you are “Free to be... you and me!”
